FCC Analytics Limited (“FCCA”, “we”, “us”, “our”) builds its business on trust between our customers and ourselves. To preserve the confidentiality of all personal data you provide to us, we maintain the following privacy principles:

Our Privacy Principles

Transparency We are committed to clarity about the collection and use of personal data. We provide detailed notices explaining how personal data may be used and processed.

Fair and Lawful Usage We ensure that all data collection, processing, and storage is lawful and conducted only where we have a legitimate reason.

Limited Purposes Data is collected strictly for specified, lawful purposes and is not used for other, incompatible purposes without necessary adjustments to comply with applicable laws.

Data Minimization and Adequacy Our data practices are proportionate — ensuring we process sufficient data to conduct our business without collecting or retaining excessive amounts.

Data Quality and Accuracy We maintain high standards of data quality and integrity, with mechanisms to keep data up-to-date and accurate.

Data Security and Retention Data is retained securely in accordance with robust retention policies and securely disposed of when no longer needed. Access to data is strictly limited to those with a legitimate business need.

Training and Awareness Employees with access to personal data are provided with training on their data protection responsibilities.

Data Subject Rights We respect and facilitate the rights of data subjects under applicable privacy laws, including access to data, correction, and deletion requests.

Data Masking / Pseudonymization We employ data masking and pseudonymization or other techniques to protect sensitive personal data from unauthorized access during processing and storage, ensuring privacy and reducing the risk of data exposure.

Third Parties and Data Transfers When engaging third parties or transferring data, we ensure the protection of data through equivalent privacy standards. Data transfers are conducted lawfully with appropriate safeguards.

Data Breach Notification

In the event of a data breach that is likely to result in a risk to individuals' rights and freedoms, FCCA will notify the relevant supervisory authority without undue delay and, when applicable, the data subjects.

Responsibilities and Compliance

Data Protection Officer Our Data Protection Officer oversees data privacy governance and is the primary contact for data privacy issues. The DPO ensures policy compliance and liaises with regulatory bodies as required.

Employee Compliance All employees are required to understand and adhere to this policy as part of their employment obligations.
